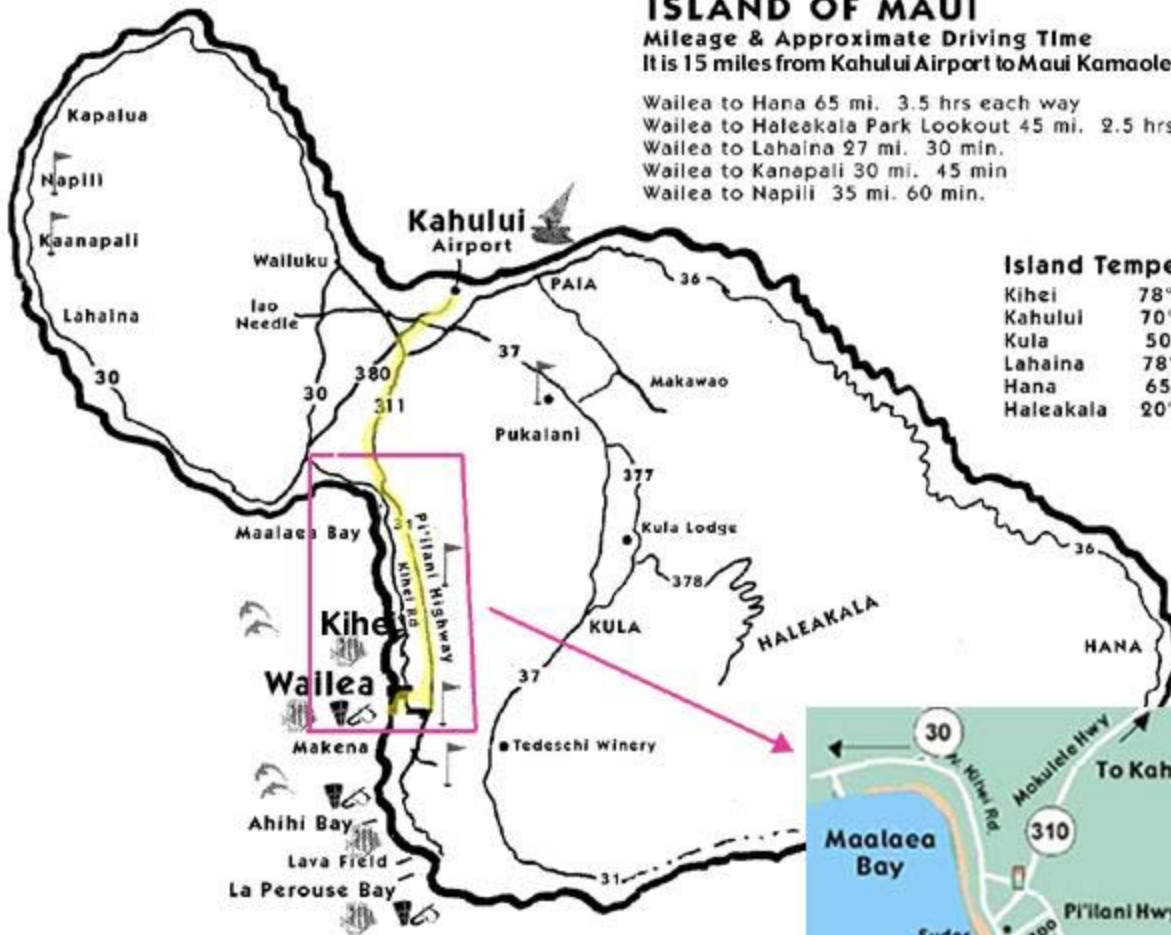


## ISLAND OF MAUI

Mileage & Approximate Driving Time  
It is 15 miles from Kahului Airport to Maui Kamaole

Wailea to Hana 65 mi. 3.5 hrs each way  
Wailea to Haleakala Park Lookout 45 mi. 2.5 hrs each way  
Wailea to Lahaina 27 mi. 30 min.  
Wailea to Kanapali 30 mi. 45 min.  
Wailea to Napili 35 mi. 60 min.



### Island Temperatures

Kihei	78°F. to 85°F
Kahului	70°F to 80°F
Kula	50°F to 80°F
Lahaina	78°F to 85°F
Hana	65°F to 80°F
Haleakala	20°F to 55°F

### Driving Instructions From Kahului Airport: (Follow signs for Kihei, then Wailea/Makena)

1. Exit Airport, and stay on Highway 380, bearing left at light (you will pass K-Mart on your left).
2. Go straight ahead for about 1 mile. Turn LEFT at the signal for Hwy 311 (Mokulele Hwy)
3. Follow for about 6 miles until you come to Hwy 31 (Pi'ilani Highway) (pee ee' lah nee).
4. Turn LEFT onto Highway 31. Go approximately 6 miles.
5. Turn right on Keonekai Dr (1st right after mile marker #9).

If you go too far, turn onto Kilohana Dr (first Wailea Village boundary signs on your right) and turn Right on Kihei Rd.

6. Follow the road down the hill toward the water until you reach the stop sign at S. Kihei Rd.

7. Turn LEFT onto S. Kihei Rd. 3rd complex on your left is Maui Kamaole. (past Hale Kamaole)

8. Turn LEFT into the entrance drive of Maui Kamaole and follow it to the LEFT into the parking lot for building H (Hibiscus).

Your reserved parking slot is H-19.

9. H-209 is a corner unit on the second floor of the building at the end of parking lot. Go up the left hand stairs. H-209 is the door on your left.
